



HIGHWAY 20 IN VAUDREUIL-DORION: QUEBEC LIBERAL PARTY COMMITS TO FINALLY DELIVERING THE BYPASS

Vaudreuil-Dorion, August 30, 2026 — A Liberal government will register the Highway 20 bypass project in Vaudreuil-Dorion with the Quebec Infrastructure Plan (QIP) without delay, at the outset of a new mandate, pledge Olivier Bertin-Mahieux and James Hughes, Quebec Liberal Party candidates in Soulanges and Vaudreuil.

The growing population of Vaudreuil-Soulanges can no longer be held hostage by the gridlock caused by the only stretch of Highway 20 in Quebec that still takes the form of an urban boulevard, dotted with traffic lights.

"For decades, boulevard Harwood in Vaudreuil-Dorion — sitting at the heart of a corridor that carries more than 75% of trade between Ontario, Quebec and the United States — has burdened road users, from Rivière-Beaudette to Île-Perrot, with needless delays, constant congestion and infrastructure dangerously ill-equipped for the volume it must carry."

This is not a new problem. The project has been proposed, studied, approved, delayed and cancelled repeatedly, with nothing yet delivered for the population and road users, who collectively lose millions of hours idling in avoidable traffic.

Underinvestment and poor maintenance of infrastructure have weighed on Quebecers for far too long. The studies are complete, the land has been expropriated: frustration and delay have reached a breaking point, and the time for half-measures is over.

"The people of Vaudreuil-Soulanges have been waiting for this bypass for too long. The studies are done, the land is ready — all that's missing is the political will to act. A Liberal government will register this project with the Quebec Infrastructure Plan at the very start of its mandate, so this file finally gets resolved,"
